

Prof. Brahmachari wins 6th BioSpectrum Person of the Year 2008 Award

Prof. Samir Kumar Brahmachari, Director General CSIR, has been awarded the 6th BioSpectrum Person of the Year award 2008. The Award has been given to him for his significant contributions to the field, and in particular to his enormous achievements in the past twelve months including “publication of the Indian Human Genome Map (IGVdb), The Open (Source) Drug Discovery Programme and for bringing the prestigious HUGO meeting to India for the first time ever.” The Award consists of a trophy and a citation.
