DETAILED TERMS AND CONDITIONS ;

The sale will be governed by the following conditions :-

- i) The bidder is required to submit Earnest Money of Rs.5000/- (Rs. five thousand only) for each vehicle separately drawn in favour of Joint Secretary (Admin), CSIR, New Delhi and payable at New Delhi. Payment by cheque or cash shall not be accepted.
- ii) Tenders received without demand draft towards Earnest Money will not be considered and shall not be accepted.
- iii) The successful bidder will be required to deposit the bid amount by means of cash with Cashier, CSIR within two working days of the acceptance of the bid.
- iv) The earnest money of the successful bidder(s) will be released only after he deposits the sale proceeds. Earnest money will not be adjusted as sale proceeds and be forfeited if he fails to honour the bid.
- v) The delivery of the sold vehicle will be arranged only after the successful bidder submits documentary evidence in support of residential status (Ration Card/Voters Identity Card in case of individual and Registration Certificate in case of firms etc.).
- vi) The sold vehicle will be removed by the successful bidder(s) within 48 hours of depositing the money at their own expenses.
- vii) The vehicle will be disposed of on "AS IS WHERE IS BASIS" and no guarantee for its worthiness or quality will be given by the Council.
- viii) The successful bidder(s) will also be responsible for getting the Registration certificate of the vehicle transferred in his name at his own cost expeditiously. The office will not be responsible for any lapse on his part in this regard.
- ix) The bidder(s) will not be allowed to withdraw their bids, failing which their earnest money will be forfeited.
- x) The Joint Secretary (Admin) reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason thereof.

The quotations addressed to Joint Secretary (Admin), CSIR, New Delhi in a sealed cover should be dropped in the Tender Box placed at Reception latest by 2.30 P.M on 25.1.2010. The cover should be prominently superscribed with the words "Tender for purchase of condemned vehicles". The tenders received in time will be opened at 3.00 P.M on the same day in the presence of the authorised representatives of the bidders, if any.
