Sub: Vigilance Administration - Role of Vigilance Officers - regarding.

Sir,

Central Vigilance Commission (CVC) has been emphasizing from time to time the need to make the vigilance mechanism effective and responsive. As a step in this direction, DG, CSIR has been pleased to approve of the following:

- Whenever a complaint is sent to the Lab./Instt for investigation, prompt and meaningful investigation is to be initiated in the matter. Inordinate delay in investigation of the complaints reflects poorly on the performance of the Vigilance Officers.
- If any serious irregularity is noticed by the Vigilance Officer of the Lab. that should be reported forthwith to the Chief Vigilance Officer.
- Vigilance Officer of the Lab./Instt. shall ensure that Chief Vigilance Officer is consulted before a decision is taken in a case by the Disciplinary or Appellate Authority, irrespective of the level of officers involved.
- Vigilance Officer of the Lab/Instt shall ensure that the charge-sheets are carefully drafted covering all lapses;
- The Vigilance Officer shall take utmost care in sending the monthly/quarterly/annual reports of vigilance/disciplinary cases. They can attach additional sheets if they want to bring any special vigilance related issue to the notice of CVO.
- The Quarterly Progress Reports (QPRs) should contain details of all projects and progress relating thereto and the Vigilance Officer of the Lab./Instt. shall be responsible for its accuracy.
- Vigilance Officer of the lab/Instt. shall ensure that whenever a case is being referred to Central Vigilance Commission for its advice, all the documents related with the case along with bio-data of the concerned official(s) and views of the disciplinary authority are sent to the Chief Vigilance Officer;

8. The Vigilance Officer should monitor the recruitment process in the Lab./Instt. If any case of recruitment in violation of laid down rules and procedures is noticed, it should be reported to the Chief Vigilance Officer.
