

CASE 2009 II

Guidelines for Scribe for Visually Challenged Persons.

The visually challenged persons who have applied for CASE 2009 II should bring their own scribe.

The visually challenged persons should make a request to this effect to the Centre Coordinator at least one day prior to the examination in the format given below.

They should bring the documents in support of their disability. It may be noted that persons suffering from not less than 40% of the relevant disability shall alone be eligible for the benefit of reservation.

The visually challenged person shall be given an additional time of 30 minutes in Part A (objective) and 20 minutes (twenty) in Part B (written) examination.

The scribe will not be paid any expenditure towards travel / scribe charge etc.
