Sub: Convening of meeting of DPC for the post of US/AO for the VY 2011 - 2012

The panel for the post of DS/COA for the vacancy year 2011 - 2012 was notified vide CSIR OM dated 03.03.2011 vide which 08 US/AOs have been empanelled for promotion to the post of DS / COA.

It may be stated that the following unfilled vacancies in the post of US/AO in the VY 2010-2011 have been carried forward as per decision dated 29.07.2010 of DG CSIR:

Consequent upon notification of panel dated 03.03.2011 for the post of DS / COA, the following anticipated and resultant vacancies in US/AO have been made available:

UR 06, SC 03, ST 01 (total 10)

The same have been distributed in the ratio of 2:1 as per details given below :

ZOC: Para 6.1.1 of DoPT OM dated 10.04.1989 provides that where promotions are to be made by selection method as prescribed in the recruitment rules, the DPC shall, for the purpose of determining the number of officers who will be considered from out of those eligible officers in the feeder grade(s), restrict the field of choice as under with reference to the number of clear regular vacancies proposed to be filled in the year:

Thus, ZOC is a field of choice and the eligible officers in the feeder grade have to be selected restricting it to the field of choice.

DG CSIR approved on 29.07.2010 to carry forward unfilled vacancies earmarked to SO (G) / PS in a vacancy year to the next vacancy year. In the VY 2010-2011, 01 & 04 vacancies earmarked for SO (G) / PS, respectively, have remained unfilled due to non recommendation of DPC. Accordingly, the total 05 vacancies are to be carried over to the next VY ie 2011-2012. Thus out of 15 vacancies, 10 vacancies (15 – 05) will be allocated to SO (G) and PS in the ratio of 2:1 as per ASRP Rules, which is 07 : 03, respectively.

CF – Carried forward unfilled vacancies of last VY ie 2010-2011

~ There are 29 PSs who have completed 08 years approved service as on 01.01.2011. As per information received from the Directors of Labs/Instts, 18 PSs (including one SC in the EZOC) have gained one year experience of SO (G).

The revised ZOC for PS is 18. As per information received from Lab/Instt, only 14 PSs have been certified to have acquired one year SO (G) work experience and 04 PSs do not fulfill the condition of one year SO (G) experience. In view of the provisions of Para 6.1.1 quoted above, we have to go down the list to identify such PSs as fulfill the necessary condition of SO (G) experience as required under rules.

Accordingly, the following candidates beyond serial number 18 in the list of PSs are eligible to be included in the ZOC:

- DJN Prasad, PS, CCMB
- SP Kapil, PS, CBRI
- Sunil Kumar, PS, CSIR Hqrs.

As regard 18th candidate, it is stated that as against 03 posts reserved for SCs only one SC namely Sh Mange Ram is available in the ZOC, but he does not fulfill the condition of SO (G) experience and hence is ineligible. Therefore, we have to extend the ZOC to 5 times the vacancies (ie 35) restricting it to 29. Accordingly, Sh Benudhar Mahalik (SC) becomes eligible for being called for interview. Hence we may consider him and call him for interview against the EZOC.

It is further stated that Directors of Labs / Instts including CSIR Hqrs of following PSs have certified that they have assimilated the experience which qualifies as an equivalent of the one year SO (G) experience.
