Dear Secretary,

The National Foundation for Communal Harmony (NFCH) was set up in 1992 as an autonomous organization under the Societies Registration Act, 1860, with the main objective of promoting communal harmony and strengthening national integration. In addition, The Foundation also provides financial assistance for effective rehabilitation of children rendered orphan or destitute in communal, caste, ethnic or terrorist violence. Upto March 2010, the Foundation has rendered financial assistance to the tune of Rs. 35 crore to 10431 such children.

2. As in the past, this year also the Communal Harmony Campaign Week will be observed from 19th to 25th November 2010 and the Flag Day on 25th November 2010. It would be appropriate, if the Campaign Week is observed befittingly in your Ministry/Department during the said period, by organising cultural programmes, seminars, painting competitions, etc., to effectively promote the values of communal harmony and national integration. Efforts should also be made to organize a determined and sustained drive to bring about mass awakening against societal violence. The Foundation will soon be dispatching posters, sticker flags and other publicity material for Communal Harmony Campaign Week. Guidelines/steps to be taken during the Campaign Week are annexed.

3. During the Communal Harmony Campaign Week, the Foundation also raises funds to support its activities. With a view to encouraging voluntary contributions, the provisions of the CCS (Conduct) Rules, 1964, have been amended permitting Central Government employees to participate in the fund raising efforts of the Foundation. Also, all donations to NFCH are fully exempt from Income-tax under section 80G of the Income-tax Act, 1961. This may be brought to the notice of officers and staff working in your Ministry / Department and institutions / organization under your Ministry's administrative control, urging them to contribute generously towards this worthy cause.



Steps to be taken for observing the Communal Harmony Campaign and the Flag Day

- (i) Organizing intensive campaign and wide publicity for sensitizing citizens including students about the need for fostering communal harmony, national integration and fraternity through cultural programmes, debates, seminars, workshops, essay/painting competitions etc.;
- (ii) Making arrangements for circulation of fund collection boxes. Plastic, wooden or metallic boxes may be improvised with suitable openings;
- (iii) Selection of volunteers from amongst staff and students to station themselves at the entrance and other vantage points and go around the school/office buildings on the **Flag Day** for distribution of flags etc. and collection of donation;
- (iv) Making suitable arrangements for proper security of collection boxes, opening them, counting the amount collected and sending to NFCH; and
- (v) Remittance of funds so collected should be made through a demand draft/cheque to:
