Sub: Enhancement of the Ceiling on accumulation and encashment of Earned Leave.

CSIR have been receiving queries from the Labs./Instts. regarding the procedure for crediting of Earned Leave consequent upon the enhancement of Earned Leave from 240 to 300 days vide GOI OM No. 14028/7/97-Estt. (1) dated 7.10.1997.

In this regard, I am directed to clarify that since there is no change in the procedure, the existing procedure for crediting of earned leave shall continue to be followed till further instructions.
