Respected Dr. Jitendra Singh Ji,

As you may be aware an overarching enabling mechanism-Mera Yuva Bharat (MY Bharat) powered by technology, for youth development and youth led development has been established under the Department of Youth Affairs.

MY Bharat was launched by Hon'ble Prime Minister of India during the culminating event of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav at Kartavya Path, New Delhi, on National Unity Day, i.e., 31.10.2023. A digital platform for MY Bharat https://www.mybharat.gov.in/ was also launched by the Hon'ble Prime Minister. This digital platform proposes to connect youth with volunteering programs in different sectors. This would enable youth to engage with the community to participate in developmental tasks and also develop leadership skills.

The issue of departmental initiatives for volunteering that could be taken up under the MY Bharat digital platform, was discussed in a meeting chaired by Hon'ble Minister for Education, Shri Dharmendra Pradhan Ji, with other Ministers and senior officers from various Ministries on 8th December 2023. A presentation was made during the meeting, and is enclosed herewith. It was discussed in the meeting that many Departments have considerable scope for running programs that can engage volunteers. Such programs would allow youth to participate in initiatives that benefit the local communities and can help improve the abilities of youth at the same time. Hence, you are requested to kindly instruct your Departments to:

- (1) Identify programs to engage youth in activities beneficial to the community relevant to your sector;
- (2) Develop outreach strategies to disseminate information about the potential of the MY Bharat platform among stakeholders so that maximum numbers of youth can utilise the services of the platform;
- (3) Develop promotional material for volunteers and Department officials for executing such programs.

For running such Departmental volunteering programs, the following would be made available to each Department on the MY Bharat digital platform:

- (i) A dedicated web page to list campaign theme for volunteering.
- (ii) The web page would list activities that could be taken up by volunteers.
- (iii) Page to have downloadable creatives as drawn up by Ministry concerned.
- (iv) Facility to generate events on different activities would be available.
- (v) Facility to upload photos and media on given page would be available.

You are requested to kindly give your valuable inputs on the above, at the earliest. You are also requested to nominate a Nodal Officer for the MY Bharat Platform from your Departments and intimate the same to us. Mera Yuva Bharat (MY Bharat) sets up a 'phygital' ecosystem

It aims to combine physical activities with opportunities to connect youth digitally (https://mybharat.gov.in) and empower young individuals to become catalysts for community transformation.

Each Ministry to have a separate web page for campaign as conceived by them

- 1. Web page would list campaign theme for volunteering.
- 2. Web page would list activities possible for volunteers.
- 3. Ministry to identify Nodal officers for the campaign.
- 4. Page to have downloadable creatives as drawn up by Ministry
- 5. Facility to generate events on different activities would be available.
- 6. Facility to upload photos and media on Department page would be available.





Suggested Activities by Ministry:

- 1. Build Poshan Vatika for Anganwadis.
- 2. Donate toys/other items for Anganwadis.
- 3. Adopt an anganwadi.
- 4. Intensive Campaign in Poshan Pakhwada.
- 5. To help in creches for working mothers.





Youth-Police Joint Learning Programme

- Introduction: Adopted for implementation in Police Departments in 20 states of the country.
- Implementation Agency: The project is being implemented through field organisations of Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India in collaboration with the Police Departments of all States/UTs. For students, the programme is open for all colleges/institutions recognized by the UGC, irrespective of their enrolment with NSS. For non-students, they must be matriculates and complete Adhaar-based KYC via My Bharat platform.
- Objective of Programme: To apprise youth about police-related work and deploy them in police-related tasks. Also to improve the cognitive and people skills of youth.
