

DG, CSIR & Secretary, DSIR"	<p>The search cum selection committee shall consist of 5 members including chairperson of the committee as under:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">a. DG, CSIR as Chairperson - Ex-officiob. Three eminent Scientists /Technologists/ Experts, at least two out of which should be external to the CSIR/DSIRc. One of the Secretaries of the Scientific Departments <p>Note: If the candidates being considered for the post is a retired Secretary to the Govt. of India, in such case, notwithstanding anything contained in this rule, the search cum Selection Committee shall be chaired by Cabinet Secretary or Principal Scientific Adviser (PSA) to Government of India or Member, NITI Aayog; and DG, CSIR shall be the co-chairperson.</p>
